



# PRODUCT OVERVIEW



# POWERING ON/OFF



## 1. Connect to the power/electricity

Plug the AC adapter into the DC IN power socket on your projector;  
Plug the AC adapter into an electrical outlet.

## 2. Turn On:

Press and hold Power button on your projector for 2 seconds to turn it on.


## 3. Manual Focus:

Slide the Focus ring on the right side of your projector to sharpen the image.

## 4. Turn Off:

Press the Power button on your projector twice to turn it off or press Power button on the Remote to turn it off.

# USE A MOUSE AS A CONTROLLER



Mouse (optional) helps control the smart projector conveniently.

- 1, Click the Left button to enter the menu.
- 2, Click the Right button to close the window.

## Entering Text

You can enter text using the on-screen keyboard, which provides a layout similar to a desktop computer keyboard. Some apps open it automatically. In others, open it by entering where you want to type.

## Projecting an HDMI Source or an Apple Device

You can project an HDMI source when connecting your projector to a laptop, PC, tablet or Blu-ray player, DVD player. If you have an Apple device, you need to get a Lighting Digital AV Adapter (not included).


1. Turn on the projector.
  2. Connect your projector to the laptop or other devices via the supplied HDMI cable. For Apple devices, connect the devices to the HDMI cable with the Lighting Digital AV Adapter, then connect the HDMI cable to the projector.
  3. Enter Home Screen > Source > HDMI.
  4. Operate your laptop, or Apple device to select the content you want to project.

## Projecting a AV Source

You can project an AV source when connecting your projector to a TV STB (set top box) or DVD player.

1. Turn on the projector.
2. Connect your projector to the TV STB or DVD player via the supplied AV cable.
3. Enter Home Screen > Source > AV.
4. Operate your TV STB or DVD player to select the content you want to project.




## Projecting from a USB flash drive/microSD card

You can project from a USB flash drive/microSD card if you have one installed.

1. Turn on the projector.
2. Enter Home Screen > Source > USB/SD.
3. Open the file you want to project.





## Ushare & AirPlay Mirroring

Ushare is an application through which wireless connection between your phone and the projector can be achieved. You can stream music, photos, and videos from your mobile phone to your projector. And with Ushare or AirPlay Mirroring, you can display your phone screen on your projector.

### Use Ushare

1. Enter Home Screen > Apps > Ushare
2. Use your phone to download and install the Ushare Application by scanning the QR-code or visiting the website shown on the bottom of the projection screen; also shown on the bottom left of the Home Screen.
3. Connect your phone and your projector to the same Wi-Fi network (see Connecting to Wi-Fi).
4. Enter installed Ushare application on your phone and connect to the device name shown on bottom left of the Home Screen, then select the content you want to project.

## NOTES:

To use Ushare Mirroring, your smart phone's system version should be above Android OS 5.0. For iOS device's mirroring, please reference to Use AirPlay below.



1. Connect your device to "concox007-5g"
2. Visit "<http://192.168.1.57>" with web browser or scan the QR-code to download app.
3. Launch UShare and click 'UShare-1736' to connect.

## Use AirPlay

1. Connect your iOS device and your projector to the same Wi-Fi network.
2. On your iOS device, swipe up from the bottom of your screen to open Control Center.
3. Tap AirPlay
4. Tap the name of the device you want to stream content to.

## NOTES

When you choose an AirPlay device, audio, photos, and videos from your iOS device will play on your projector.


If you turn on Mirroring, you'll see your entire iOS screen on the projection screen.

To use AirPlay, you need one of these devices: iPhone 5 or later for AirPlay Mirroring; iPad 2 or later for AirPlay Mirroring; iPod touch 5th generation or later for AirPlay Mirroring.




## Turn AirPlay off

1. On your iOS device, swipe up from the bottom of your screen to open Control Center.
2. Tap AirPlay.
3. Tap your device at the top of the AirPlay list.




# FILES

Quickly access all of your images, videos, audio clips and other types of files on your internal storage and the micro SD card or a connected USB device.



Enter *Home Screen* > *Setting* to find all the tools for customizing and configuring your projector.



## Connecting to Wi-Fi

Wi-Fi is a wireless networking technology that can provide wireless Internet access.

1. Enter *Home Screen* > *Setting* > *Wi-Fi*.
2. Slide the Wi-Fi switch to the ON position to turn on Wi-Fi.
3. The projector will scan for available Wi-Fi networks.
4. Choose a network name to connect to it.
5. If the network is secured, enter the password and enter Connect.



## NOTES:

Your projector automatically connects to the previously used Wi-Fi network when they are in range.

When Wi-Fi is connected, your projector can notify you by showing \* (  ) in the status bar.

## Adding a Wi-Fi network

You can add a Wi-Fi network if the network does not broadcast its name (SSID), or add a Wi-Fi network when you are out of range. To connect to a secured network, you first need the security details from the network administrator.

1. Home Screen > Setting > Wi-Fi.
2. Slide the Wi-Fi switch to the ON position to turn on Wi-Fi.
3. Enter Add network.
4. Enter the network SSID (name); if necessary, enter security or other network configuration details.
5. Enter Save.

## Sharing your device as a Wi-Fi Hotspot

You can share your device with other devices by turning your projector into a Wi-Fi hotspot.

1. Home Screen > Setting > System > Net and Location setting > Wi-Fi hotspot
2. Slide the Wi-Fi hotspot switch to the ON position to turn on Wi-Fi hotspot.
3. Enter Settings to set the SSID (name) and password.
4. Enter Save.

## Connecting to Bluetooth Devices

Bluetooth is a short-range wireless communication technology. Phones or other devices with Bluetooth capabilities can exchange information wirelessly.

1. Enter *Home Screen* > *Setting* > *Bluetooth*.
2. Slide the Bluetooth switch to the NO position.

## NOTES:


When Bluetooth is on, the  icon will appear in the status bar.

## Changing the Device name

1. Enter *Home Screen* > *Setting* > *Bluetooth*.
2. Slide the Bluetooth switch to the ON position to turn on Bluetooth.
3. Set name and password.
4. Enter Save.



# SYSTEM SETTINGS



## Applications manage:

View and manage apps on your projector. You can stop the downloading app, uninstall or disable the app, or clear data and cache.

## Net and Location setting:

View the Network Status, and you also can set the Wi-Fi Direct and Wi-Fi hotspot here (See Using Wi-Fi Direct and Sharing your device as a Wi-Fi Hotspot).

**Language and Input :** Select your language and configure text input settings.

**NOTES :** The model only supports English language.

## Date and Time:

Set date, time, time zone and how date and time are displayed. You can also use network-provided data. Your projector can be controlled by a Timing Switch to shut down and restart automatically.

**Timer mode:** Once / every day

**Shut down time:** Turn on Shutdown and enter the Shutdown time to set the time.

**Restart time:** Turn on Restart and enter the Restart time to set the time.

**Miracast:** You can project media wirelessly from a Miracast-capable (Wi-Fi display capable) device to the projector.

**Factory Menu:** Factory menu is only available for technical supporting.

**Recovery:** Reset your projector to factory default settings. All your personal data on the internal storage will be erased.

# DEVICE SETTINGS



## Image

You can configure the Image Quality, Color Temperature and Aspect Ratio.

## Sound

You can configure the Sound Mode and Voice Balancer.

## Advanced

Includes Display Settings and Restore Defaults.

## Display Settings:

Projection Mode: Close AUTO Rotate, then you can configure Projection Mode.

Keystone Adjust: Close AUTO Keystone, then you can configure AUTO Keystone.

AUTO Keystone: Auto keystone allows your projector to make the output image rectangular automatically.

AUTO Rotate: Auto rotate allows your projector to automatically change the orientation of some on-screen content based on the position of the device.

## Restore Defaults:

Reset your Device settings of the projector to factory default settings.


All your setting data in the Device settings will be erased.

## 3D

You can use your projector to watch 3D videos with active 3D glasses (3D glasses is optional).

## 3D setting

**LR View Switch:** You can adjust the images for left eye and right eye to match the frequency of the displayed images until you feel better.



## 3D Format

1. Your projector can finish the format conversion after detecting a 3D video, and then present a ready 3D video if you are using the native player to play videos.
2. If you are watching 3D videos online or from other source, like HDMI, you can adjust the video mode manually here.

For Left-and-right format video, please select 3D-UD to watch 3D videos;

For Up-and-down format video, please select 3D-LR to watch 3D videos.

If you want to back to Non-3D video, please select 2D or 3D-2D-LR, or 3D-2D-UD.

# ETHERNET CONNECTION

## Power Setting

**Brightness Mode:** Set the brightness of the display, including Mode, Warm, Cool, Eco and Music.  
**Power Timer:** Set the length of working time before the projector turn off automatically (also see *Home Screen > Setting > System > Date and Time > Timing Switch*).


## Source

See *Projection > Projecting an HDMI Source or an Apple Device* and *Projecting an AV Source*

## ETHERNET CONNECTION:

Your projector can connect to a wired network with the Ethernet cables connection.





## Wallpaper:

Select a background image for the home screen.

## Boot animation Settings:

You can create your own boot animation and make it shown when start up the projector.

## Floating Window:

Floating Window is a shortcut icon for Device Setting.

## Power On Options:

Your projector has two options for Power On.

## Auto Power On:

By connecting to the power/electricity to turn on your projector directly.

## Button Power On:

After connecting to the power/electricity, pressing the Power Button on the projector to turn on your projector.

**Source Options:** You can keep your projector in the same source every time it starts up.

**HDMI:** Your projector will project the HDMI source every time it starts up.

**AV:** Your projector will project the AV source every time it starts up.

**Auto:** Your projector will project any available source every time it starts up.

**Auto Shutdown if no signal:** Your projector will shut down automatically if none signal detected within 10 minutes.

# SOFTWARE UPDATE


Check for available updates for software installed on your device and manage the update process. There are two ways to update your projector software, Online Update and Local Update.

## 1. Online Update:


You can update the system by downloading the newest software online.

## 2. Local Update:

You need to ask for help from the technical supporting about this firmware update.



View the device status, legal information and other information. You can also update your system with an updated package copied into the USB flash disk.
